With a total colocation space of 7,000 sqm, Telehouse Paris Voltaire is one of the largest data centers in Paris. With over 100 carriers on site and as the primary location for the French Internet Exchange, France-IX, Telehouse Voltaire is also the most connected data center in Paris. As the key hub for 80% of France's live internet traffic, Telehouse Voltaire has also been the recipient of the "France Oscar Security Award" from a leading French security organization for outstanding security measures, and is continuously gaining recognition from the government, mass media and related industrial associations as a prime data center and colocation site.

Voltaire is Telehouse's second data center in Paris and opened in 1999. Telehouse's Paris data centers have 19 years' experience hosting the mission critical systems of multinational corporations including gaming/media, finance, IT service providers, telecoms companies and some of the world's most recognised luxury retail brands.

Colocation:

- SFM: Rack colocation service -Customer's equipment is installed in a 19-inch, individually locked cabinet within a shared facility
- DFM: Dedicated facility colocation room with further security, adaptable to individual needs (From 20 sqm)

Power:

- Two incoming 10MW lines each from separate suppliers, with two dedicated cables
- 6 x 2,000 kVA generator sets deployed in N+1 configuration
- Can provide up to 72 hours back up continuously
- UPS with 150 to 400 kVA in N+1 to N+N configurations with STS, with 20 minutes autonomy
- Protection of electrical systems, lightening protection and surge suppressor
